

Terroir: Decomposed granite in the area surrounding Darling Hills. Hot summers moderated by

the cool Atlantic.

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, no irrigation

about the harvest

Yield: 2-4 t/ha

Balling at Harvest: 22°B

in the cellar

Crush and destalk, 12 days fermentation at 14°C
