blend information

95%Shiraz, 3% Malbec, 2% Grenache

food suggestions

Serve with oven roasted lamb or smoked duck.

in the vineyard

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, no irrigation

about the harvest

Yield: 5.5-6.5 t/ha

Balling at Harvest: 24-25°B

in the cellar

Destalk and crush, 5-7 days fermentation at 20-30°C

Maturation: After malolactic fermentation of the wine is transferred into stainless tanks to which staves are added.
