airs well with a heart beef stew, slow cooked pork belly, oxtail stew or any venison dishes.

in the vineyard

eep, dark coloured laterite soils from decomposed Granite. The sunny days and cool venings influenced by the nearby Atlantic Ocean have a positive impact.

about the harvest

rapes are hand-picked from Bush Vine vineyards with no irrigation and a yield of about 4-6 onnes/ha.

in the cellar

old soaked for 2 days and then fermented in open tanks with a combination of pump overs nd punch downs. Alcoholic fermentation is finished on the skins with extended skin contact. ged for 18 months in a combination of French and American oak barrels to perfect this wine.
