tasting notes

This wine shows a full flavoured palate with layers of tropical fruit, aromas of ripe yellow gooseberries, green figs and asparagus. A well-balanced wine with a crisp acidity and green undertones that lingers on the aftertaste.

food suggestions

This wine pairs well with seafood dishes, creamy chicken dishes, or a garden salad in early summer.

in the vineyard

Our farmers grow grapes on dry-land and deep-rooted bush vines. The wines reflect the ancient soils and coastal proximity for which the Darling region is so well known. In this individually crafted range, every wine tells its own story.

Bush Vines with no irrigation, South-Western facing slopes on deep granite soils and high up in the exclusive Groenekloof ward of Darling.

about the harvest

Grapes are harvested from two specifically selected blocks of vineyards.

in the cellar

Crush and destalk, 6-12 hours skin contact, 21 days fermentation at 13°C. Reductive winemaking and left on lees in Stainless Steel tanks to add complexity and depth.
